Class Standing by Course Credit lottery purposes, will be determined as follows:

- x 90 credits and above: Senior and 5th year AND current residential Graduate Students
- x 60-89 credits: Junior Student
- x 30-59 credits: Sophomore Student
- x 1-29 credits: First Year Student

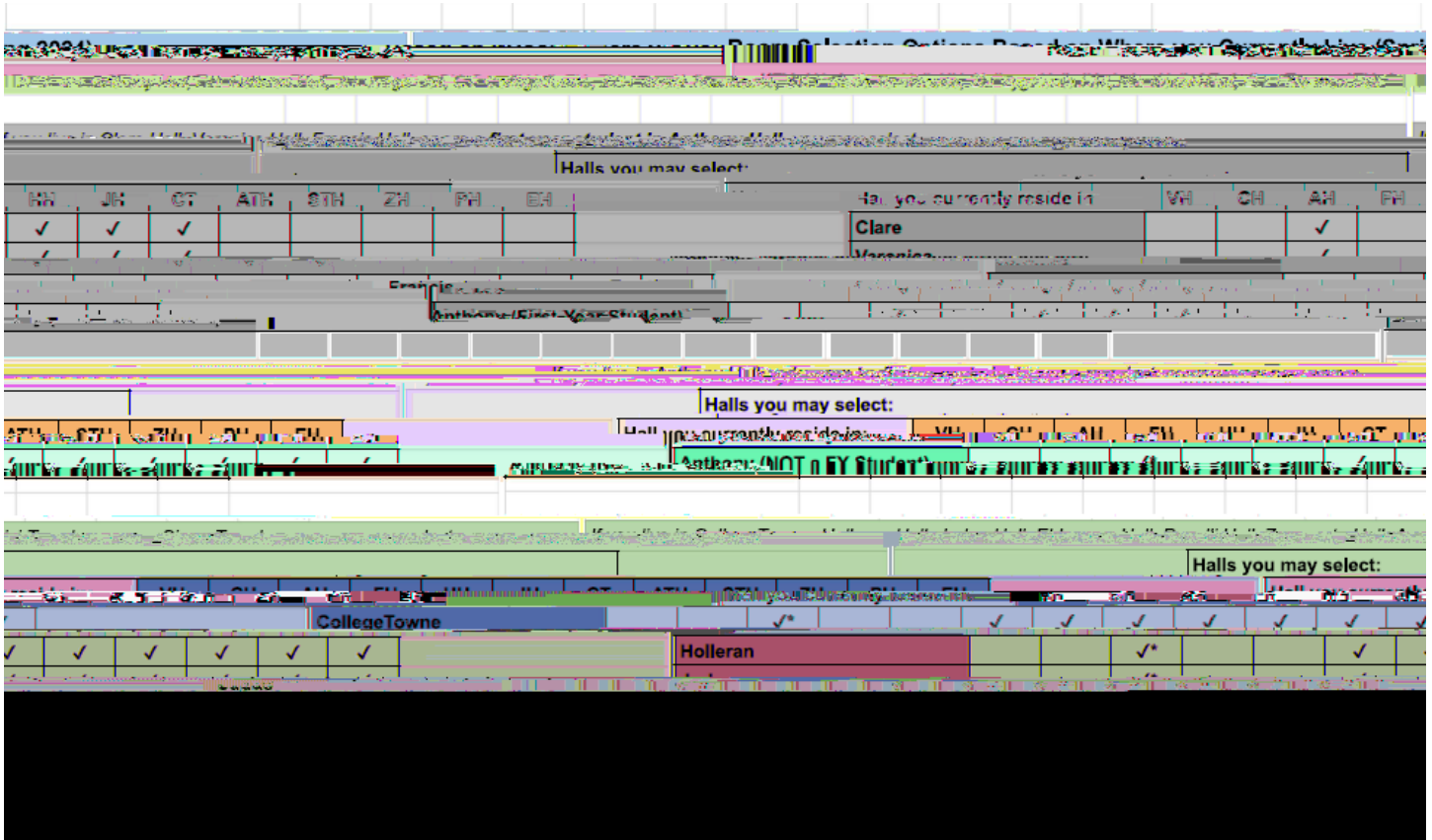
BUILDING DESCRIPTIONS
